### Safety Information - Read Before Installation

Choose a suitable location that meets all the requirements of the safety information.

- -Carefully unpack all parts and check for damage or missing parts before commencing installation.
- -Inspect the product for any damage before use.
- -The mirror is not suitable for use in Bathrooms, mirror is for indoor use only.
- -Use the appropriate fixings dependant on the type of wall inorder to mount this mirror.
- -Mirror can be hung in both portrait and landscape.

Keep these care guide instructions for future reference.

- -Do not lean the mirror against walls or other surfaces.
- -Glass used in this product is film backed.
- -Item is fragile Handle with care to avoid damage or injury.
- -If mirror glass becomes damaged, remove from the wall and dispose of appropriately.
- -Children should be supervised around this product.
- -Ensure the mirror is installed using both of the support cables.

## Cleaning Instructions

Wood - only use a soft cloth.

Brass - all types: Use a soft dry lint free cloth.

**Bronze, Nickel, Silver & Chrome:** Use a dry cloth only, no chemical cleaners.

**Glass:** We recommend using a strong alcohol such as isopropyl alcohol. Note: some modern cleaning solutions can contain chemicals that can leave a greasy film on glass.

Gilt Wood: Use a dry cloth only.

Lacquered Furniture: Furniture polish

-Any decorative parts made from other materials must be removed and cleaned separately to avoid damage.
